

### A Note From Our Rector

Hello St. Michael's! This week, I have some house keeping for you: Firstly, please plan to attend our Annual Meeting on February 5 following the 10am service. Lunch will be provided, and Kim is working on childcare possibilities. Paper ballots will be available during the annual meeting for those who prefer it, and we are electing vestry and diocesan convention delegates.

Church financials for 2022 and the 2023 Budget are approved and available further down in this Sword, and our treasurer, John Davis, will be holding a financial review meeting this Sunday following the 10am service in the conference room.

And finally, as we near my seventh anniversary as Rector of St. Michael's (September 1, 2016), the vestry and I have been planning a possible sabbatical this summer. In this diocese and in our letter of agreement, rectors are eligible for a sabbatical after 5 years with two weeks accrued per year worked, not to accrue beyond 7 years. With approval from the wardens and vestry, I plan to be on my sabbatical May 1 through July 31. Last year, Bishop Chiton encouraged me to move forward with my plans as the seventh year approached. Sabbaticals are quite different from vacations, and offer a time of growth and inward focus that is made difficult with the day to day parish activities and responsibilities. A successful sabbatical usually includes continuing education, prayer, and rest. My hope is to begin a Doctorate of Ministry, take a spiritual retreat, and travel a bit with my family. Fr. Jim Swarthout will be the supply priest for those Sundays during my sabbatical, and Deacon Tim will be covering pastoral care (pending final agreement with the diocese and Tim). The Wardens and I will be working out a more detailed plan for other responsibilities as we get closer. Blessings, friends, and see you in church, Jesse+



#### **Book Group**


