It advises on the organization [sic] and structures of the Communion, and seeks to develop common policies with respect to the world mission of the Church, including ecumenical matters".

The Anglican Centre in Rome (<http://www.anglicancentreinrome.org>) "is the permanent Anglican Communion presence in Rome. It is a living symbol of our Communion's commitment to the full visible unity of the Church. It stands for our desire to work collaboratively with all Christians for justice and peace in the world and for the flourishing of all God's children whatever their origin or status."
