**Nominated for:** 3 year term to vestry

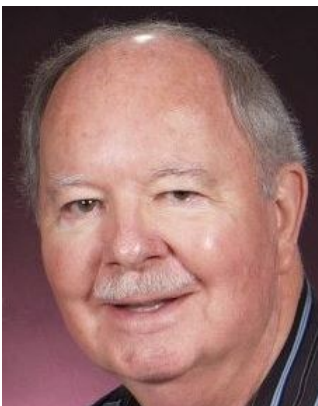
**Attending St. Michael's:** Since 1993
