Dear Church,

Lent is a holy time of the year for us Christians when we set aside time to prepare for the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our Ash Wednesday service begins by inviting us into a Holy Lent, "by self-examination and repentance." My prayer for us and for this faith community is that during this season of Lent, we will turn inward and examine ourselves first, before pointing the finger at others. It is a time to examine our lives, our choices, and our gut feelings, and to repent where necessary. It is a time to give up something or take something on in order to make a course correction in the areas we find are not in line with God's Will and Kingdom. This Lent, ask the question, "How can I be more like Jesus, and how can I be more Christ-like to the people I meet and to those I do not even get to see?" And with faith and hope, that with God, all things are possible, and grace and forgiveness are offered to anyone who asks.

Prayer to start our Lenten journey (BCP 264):

"Almighty and everlasting God, you hate nothing you have made and forgive the sins of all who are penitent: Create and make in us new and contrite hearts, that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our wretchedness, may obtain of you, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. 
Pray for Us in Times of Conflict

For it is in giving that we receive;


It is in pardoning that we are pardoned;






