NO LIFT on Easter Morning, March 31.

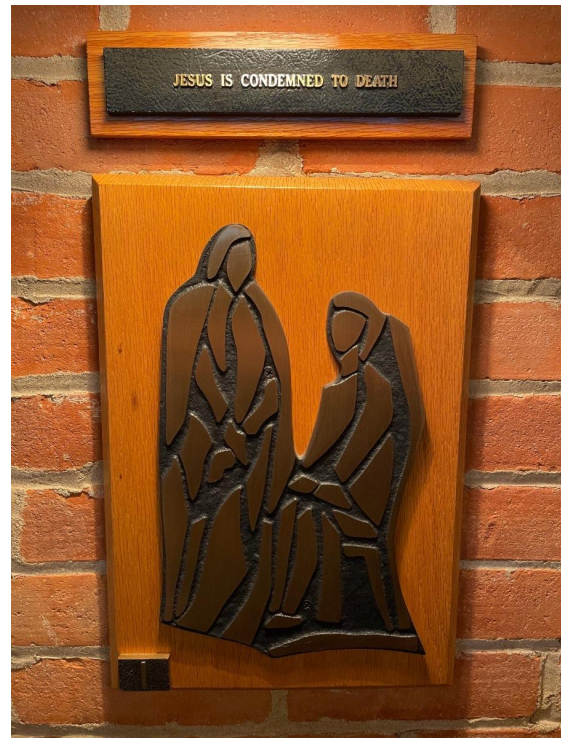

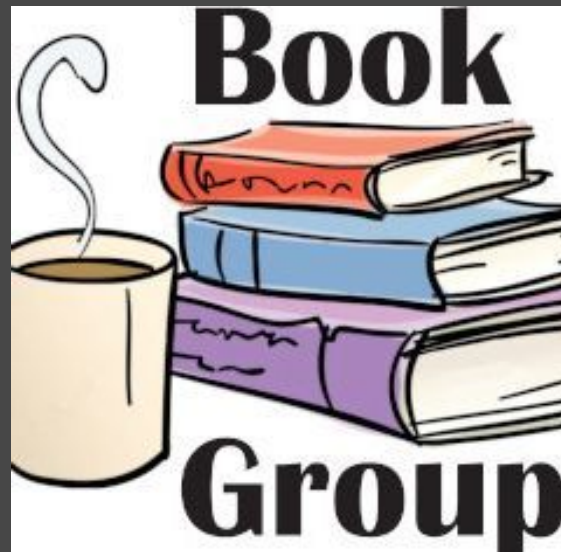


Book Group - March 20

March 29 - Good Friday Service will be at 12 PM at St. Michael's and 7 PM at Salem United Methodist Church in Barrington.

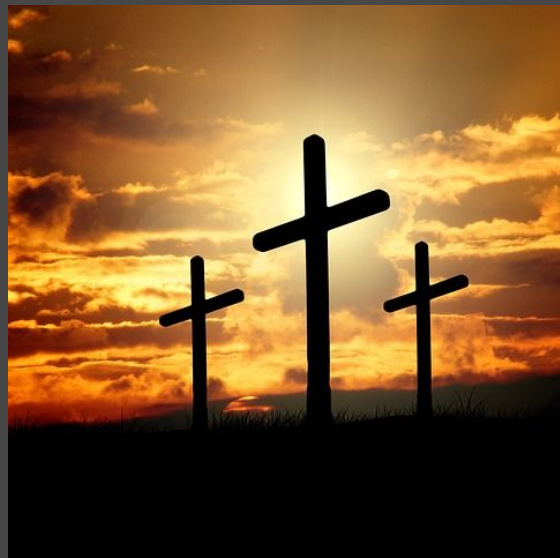
March 30 - Easter Vigil, Holy Saturday Evening service will be at 8 PM.

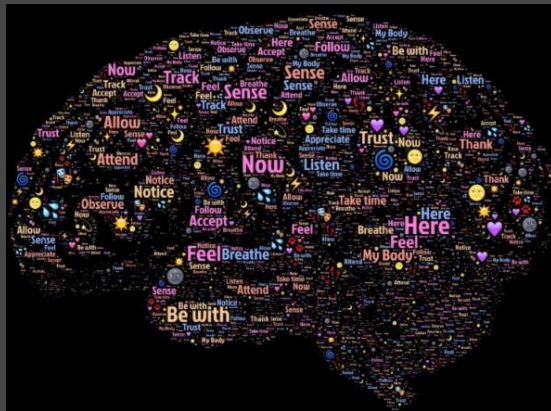
